Lambretta riders of Europe meet in Sweden

The 13 – 15 of June 600 scooterfans from all Europe are coming to Hasslö in the Swedish county of Blekinge for the jamboree EuroLambretta 2008. In the centre of it all is their common interest for the Lambretta scooter.

A scooter is a motorcycle or moped with small wheels and a protective body. The Lambretta scooter was made by the Innocenti in Italy during the years 1947 – 1971, after that fabrication was continued in Spain and India but has now ceased. To the enthusiasts the Lambretta of course is the most beautiful vehicle ever made.

The EuroLambretta is the biggest annual jamboree for the Lambretta fans. It has been arranged since 1989, the latest years in Austria, France and Germany. This year is the first time ever the EuroLambretta will be held in Sweden. The weekend 13-15 of June around 600 participants will be coming to Hasslö in the Swedish county of Blekinge. The English are most numerous, around 200, but guests will be coming from as far away as Vietnam, Hong Kong and the USA.
